This is of widespread relevance as distinct from the role of specialist veterinary pharmacists involved with livestock and the farming community. This title provides an introduction to the subject of veterinary pharmacy, and should equip pharmacists and pharmacy students with the knowledge necessary to allow them to become involved in this rewarding area.
