You will be touched by his story and the stories of several other people who have suffered critical health issues. Pat's book is a reference book for heart patients, cancer patients and those going through traumatic health conditions. His book recounts the events leading up to his sudden cardiac arrest, his rescue and what his experiences in death were. The book also recounts his recovery period and what steps other people can take to prevent a heart attack. Finally, understand how to cope with serious health conditions. Pat has had a career working for automobile manufacturers and has served as an automotive consultant to car dealers from coast to coast. He began writing after his sudden cardiac arrest and recovery and has published several short stories and books from fiction to non-fiction.
