Finally, addressing the formidable difficulties posed for tensed accounts of time by the Special Theory of Relativity, he suggests that a modified version of the theory, compatible with the account of time in this book, is to be preferred to the standard version. *Time, Tense, and Causation* is rich in sophisticated and stimulating discussions of many of the deepest problems of metaphysics.
