Diderot's *Encyclopédie* entry on architecture followed his entry on Noah's Ark; architecture could only find its way after the Flood. In these thirteen essays, written over a span of forty years, Damisch takes on other histories and theories of architecture to trace a unique trajectory of architectural structure and thought. The essays are, as Vidler says, "a set of exercises" in thinking about architecture.

In keeping with the prophecies, Bashir the Second (Hadrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmood Ahmad, Khalifatul Masih II ra) was born on 12th January 1889. He died at the age of 76 after a life of tremendous achievement and is remembered as Musleh Mau'ud or the Promised Reformer.
