Thirdly, the book focuses on the ways in which the reformed policy was sustained during the 1990s.

Part 4 comprises studies of training in relation to labour market structures, each of which indicates similar alternatives for training policy in Britain - alternatives whose relevance and political prospects can only be enhanced by the demise of Thatcher government deregulatory policies.
