The two stories were combined under the title of the first in the first book edition, published in 1920 by A. C. McClurg. In order of writing, the book follows *Jungle Tales of Tarzan*, a collection of short stories about the ape-man's youth. Chronologically, it follows *Tarzan and the Jewels of Opar*.
